“Follow Your Art! A Soleful Sculpture Celebration”**

The Arts Council of Lake Oswego invites everyone to “Follow Your Art! A *Soleful Sculpture Celebration*” on Wednesday, August 26, 6-8 p.m. at Millennium Plaza Park in downtown Lake Oswego. This **free** event will celebrate the addition of 14 new sculptures to the *Gallery Without Walls*, a year-round exhibit of public art located throughout downtown Lake Oswego.

The Celebration will include social time with the artists; docent-led tours of the new sculpture; art activities for kids of all ages; and live music with Zimba!, a Portland-based marimba band specializing in the music of Zimbabwe and southern Africa. Terrace Kitchen, Tucci, Gusto Bistro and Pizza Schmizza will be on the Plaza offering food, beer and wine for sale.

There will also be a silent auction of original artwork by several of the new sculpture artists. Proceeds from the silent auction will be used to develop a tour of the *Gallery Without Walls* for young students, as part of the Lake Oswego School District’s Art Literacy Program.

“Follow Your Art! A *Soleful Sculpture Celebration*” is sponsored by Delap.
